

Rules of the Challenge des Fous

Any cyclist who has completed the Fêlés du Grand Colombier, the Fadas du Puy Mary or the Sixphonnés du Mont Brouilly rides is automatically a candidate for the Challenge des Fous. This honorary challenge is validated to any cyclist who will have completed his three permanent rides and this by his muscular strength alone.

Only cyclists holding the rank of Nabuchodonosor des Sixphonnés du Mont Brouilly without electric assistance will be admitted to participate in this challenge.

Four grades are possible:

- the Petit Barjot grade is awarded to any cyclist who has homologated the three rides during his career;

- the Grand Azimuté grade is awarded to any rider who has completed all three rides in the course of a year from day to day;

- The Totally Crazy grade is awarded to any rider who has completed all three rides within a maximum of one month from day to day.

-The grade Intenable Déchaîné is awarded to any rider who has completed all three rides in three consecutive days.

The homologation card acting as a diploma will be given to the participant at the time of his first validation of one of the three rides, he will have to transmit it at the same time as his route card, at the time of the following homologations of the associated rides for validation of his grade.
